

**2008 14U Spring Interleague
Brea, Fullerton Hills, La Habra, Whittier
Supplemental Rules:**

These rules have been agreed to be used by all the interleague cities at ALL SITES.
Regular home league rules are superseded.

A. Plays by ASA Rules

Exceptions:

1. All players present will bat in turn, "Bat the Bench"
2. There will be no penalty for playing with only 8 players
3. Game Time = 1:30, no new inning
4. If the game completes 7 innings in a tie, and the clock has not expired, 1 inning of international tiebreaking will be played, using the ASA rulebook format.
5. If a player arrives late, they will be added to the bottom of the lineup card with no penalty.
6. If a player has to leave the game early, no penalty will be assessed if this was announced and recorded in the umpire's pregame meeting.

When the player leaves, her spot in the lineup will be skipped, no penalty. If she leaves and it was not announced, an out will be recorded each time her spot is skipped. This does not apply to injuries – no penalty for injured players leaving a game.

7. Mercy Rule: 12 runs after 4 complete innings, 10 runs after 5 complete innings.
 - A. You can only score six (6) runs per inning.
 - B. Twelve inch (12") Worth Dream Seam ball shall be used
 - C. The home team will pay the umpires
 - D. Forfeit time is 10 minutes after the scheduled game time. 8 players must be in sight of the umpire before the 10 minutes expire
 - E. Note: **There are no pitching limitations**
 - F. Schedule change requests must be coordinated with the FHS Coordinator and approved by both teams. If you can field 8 players, play the game.

You must notify the FHS Scheduler at least 5 days in advance. Home team League must coordinate the umpire schedule change. All games should be rescheduled for dates within 13 days of the original game date. We cannot afford to stack a bunch of games after Spring Break, because of possible rainouts. Contact the other coach in rain conditions; it may not be raining in the host city. If you are a no show, and the game was not called, it will be considered a forfeit.
